First of all, we want to thank you for your service at Cedine. All the long hours of lifeguarding at the lake, in the kitchen, at the horse barn and other activities were well worth the friendships gained, personal growth developed, and the children reached for the sake of the Gospel. Please know that the sacrificial giving of your time, energy, and talents, help to shape the summer here at Cedine Bible Camp.

In preparation for the upcoming camp season, the Camp Council has made a few changes to the participation requirements in the LIT program that you need to know. With much prayer and discussion, the following revisions have been made in efforts to strengthen the program and honor the Lord through the work He has given us to do.

- As has been expressed in the past, it is our desire to have LIT's serve for the whole duration of the summer. Since this is not always possible, the **new** minimum requirement for weeks to work includes: **staff training and three additional weeks during the summer.**
- LITs who are not serving all summer, will only be able to serve during one teen camp.
- With the new MAN camp beginning this year, only those LITs who serve the whole summer will be allowed to serve the weeks of Family Relations (July 2-7) and MAN Camp (July 9-14).

We realize these changes may interfere with plans that are in the making for your summer, but we hope you will diligently pray and consider your part at Cedine this year. Please feel free to call with any questions you have regarding the above changes. We do look forward to serving with you again. You can download an application on Cedine's website, email us or call and ask for an application to be sent to you via regular mail.

Dear Leader In Training Applicant,

Thank you so much for your interest in serving the Lord with us this summer. There is a required fee of \$50.00 for all LIT applicants. This amount should be enclosed with your application, and is non-refundable. If you have been involved in the Cedine Bible Quiz program or Correspondence Course, you can use your camp certificate to cover your fee. Your application cannot be processed until your fee or camp certificate is received.

Also, we need to receive all applications by May 1st. It is necessary that we get them in time for processing, and sending out letters of acceptance so that future LITs can make plans to attend training week. This is also to prevent LIT applicants from showing up with paperwork in-hand, or with none at all. We need to know who will be coming for each week, so we can prepare each week in advance. If applicants send in applications after May 1st, there is a good chance we will be unable to place that applicant. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

It is very important that you make arrangements to attend training week. (Training Week is a requirement). We will be training summer staff for the various activities of service available. We will also spend time getting to know each other, and making decisions of when and where each should serve, if asked to stay. We will contact parents during training week regarding LIT's weeks of service, so that arrangements can be made for going home. If you are interested in training for the horse program, waterfront or lifeguard, please contact us for details. Note: the age for these opportunities is 15.

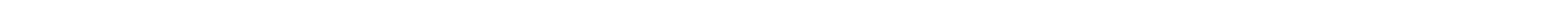

Cedine Camp Dress Code:

- Please dress *modestly* at all times in comfortable and casual clothes.

FEMALES

- Pants, skirts and shorts should not be too tight, revealing, or short (skirts and shorts are to be half-way to the knee or when your arms are down at your sides, they should be no shorter than the tip of your middle finger.) NO V-neck shirts or V-neck t-shirts.
- Dresses and tops must have 2" wide shoulder straps, and tops must be long enough to cover waist.
- One Piece swim suits only.
- Dresses and tops should not be revealing, or low-cut.

MALES

- Shirts are to be worn at all times in the area.
- Pants/Shorts must be comfortable, but not overly sagging.

EVERYONE

- A long dark shirt is required to be worn over bathing suits for guys *and* girls during LIT co-ed swim for fun night. No short or white t-shirts will be allowed as swimsuit covers.
- Everyone is required to be fully dressed going to and from the swimming area.
- Long pants and closed toed shoes are required for horseback riding.

Things *Not* to Bring:

- * Cell phones, TV, radio, tape players, CD players, playing cards, alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drugs, guns, knives, fireworks, pets, food or snacks.
- * No food is allowed in the cabins.

- You are encouraged to come to the Spring Teen Retreat to join in on a pre – training day.
- Registration for this retreat will be your responsibility. If you served last summer – this is a free retreat for you.
- Please register early – spaces fill up fast.

L. I. T.'S ARE:

- Must attend the Staff Training Week (unless prior arrangements have been made with the LIT director).
- Recommended to go home on weekends if possible.
- To participate as a camper for one week if you are 15 and under and the weeks of service apply.
- To arrive on or before Monday–12 noon and will be free to leave after 12 noon on Saturday (or when your assignment is completed for that week).

****You must call ahead and make arrangements if you are coming before Monday****

- To remember that the job assigned to you will be your first priority, but you could be called upon to volunteer in other areas of ministry as the time and need arrive.
- Are considered to be a missionary for the time of service. Please ask your church to commit to pray for you and support you as you serve.
- Recommended to rest during the times that you are free, but are allowed to join in an activity as long as it does not interfere with your assignment and the instructor of that activity.
