BRIEF HISTORY 1946-2012

Cedine was started in 1946. For the first few years the camp was held on rented grounds. In 1950, 100 acres was purchased for \$2000 and Cedine Bible Camp had a permanent home. Over the years Cedine's ministry opportunities have expanded. A Bible Institute was in operation from 1966 to 1988. The Retreat and Conference ministry began in the late 70's.

Today there is a full calendar of activities for all ages. The retreat and conference ministry provides 6 ladies' retreats, 2 men's retreats, 2 couples' retreats, 1 singles' retreat, 1 Powerwalk leadership conference as well as many outside retreats. The camping ministry offers 3 weeks of elementary camp, 2 teen weeks of camp and 1 week for middlers. New this year is 1 week for "Man Camp".

There are 2 week-long conferences offered during the summer: The Family Relations Conference designed to encourage families to spend time together and the Family Bible Conference which is more of a graded Bible conference. The camping ministry also has 2 teen retreats, one in May and one in September.

The Outreach Ministry includes the Bible Correspondence Courses, the Devotional Guide Ministry, and the Bible Quizzing Program. The new MAPS program has brought the opportunity to minister in-depth truth of the Scriptures to post high school apprentices in a 15 month program.

Cedine desires to fulfill the motto, "Not just Decisions but Disciples for Christ" through quality camp, conference, and outreach ministries.

HOUSING

Campers are placed in cabins according to age. You may request only one cabinmate of your own age on the registration form. The same camper must request you as well. Requests outside these guidelines may not be honored.

Check in time is between 2-5 p.m. on Monday. Check out time is 10 a.m. on Saturday.

CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

\$75 deposit is required. If your child is working on a correspondence course it must be started by January 31st and completed by April 30th to receive credit for the summer. Completion of the course will cover \$50 of the total camp cost.

- 2** Sending payment to reserve a place for your child:
 - \$200/\$175 (early bird) total payment (\$75 non-refundable)
 - OR-
 - \$75 non-refundable deposit which will be applied to your total. You then have the option of completing payment by April 30th or bringing the remaining balance when you come to camp.

THINGS TO BRING

- Bible and pencils or pens

CLOTHES

(Please mark all articles of clothing with camper's name.)

Cedine Bible Camp is a Christian camp and asks that campers dress in a godly and modest way. Please dress modestly at all times in comfortable and casual clothing.

Females: Pants, skirts and shorts should not be too tight, revealing, or short (half way to the knee). Dresses and tops must have 2" wide shoulder straps with a neckline high enough to

cover cleavage, and tops must be long enough to cover waist. One piece swim suits only.

Males: Shirts are to be worn at all public places. Pants/Shorts must be comfortable, but not sagging.

Any items found after a camp session will be kept for 30 days. Please call as soon as you realize what you left. You will be asked to send money to cover postage for shipping.

DIRECTIONS



Cedine is located on beautiful Watts Bar Lake northeast of Spring City, TN off of US Hwy. 27. Turn onto Rocky Springs Road (on your right 4 miles north of Spring City or on your left 18 miles south of I-40) and follow the signs 6 1/2 mi. to camp.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR RETREATS AND CONFERENCES

All deposits are non-refundable.

- There is a discount if you pay early. The Early Bird Price is \$120. *Less than 30 days before an event the charge will be \$140.*
- Private rooms will be charged an additional \$20 per night.
- We reserve the right to reassign rooms to those who have mobility needs even if you have paid in full for that room. NOTE: this is only if absolutely necessary. We make every attempt to house you where you have requested when you pay in full.
- The minimum age for adult retreats is 16. Please encourage your younger people to attend the teen retreats.
- Any items left at a retreat will be kept for 30 days. Please call as soon as you realize what you left. There will be a cost for the postage to ship your item(s) back to you.

REGISTRATION

- Please register early, as space is limited.
- Check-in time is between 2:00 - 6:00 p.m.
- Check-out time -- after lunch on last day, except for Family Conferences, which is after breakfast.
- All advance payments are non-refundable.

TRANSFERS

Transfers to another event **MUST** be made at least 14 days before the conference or retreat. You may transfer fees to an unregistered person if you are unable to attend. **No** payments may be transferred to a person who is already registered.

POLICIES

Pets, alcoholic beverages, or smoking are not allowed in any of the buildings.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Adult retreat and family conferences use Nash Hall, Grace House, Hance House, Narnia, Lakeside cottages and the village cabins which provide bed and bath linens. Couples and families are housed in individual units. Single adults are usually housed three per room.

SPECIFIC HOUSING

To reserve a specific housing unit you must send in the completed registration form along with full payment for each person requesting the unit. Please note housing is assigned as full payment is received. Some units will be reserved as much as a year in advance.

ROOMMATES

If you wish to be housed with specific roommates, please specify on the registration form. Once you arrive, we ask that you do not change rooms.

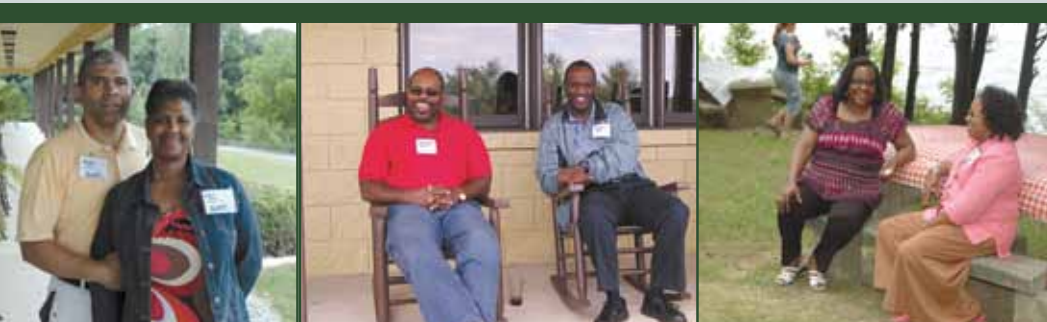
CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

If you have completed a correspondence course you must send in the award check at least two weeks in advance or it may not be honored. The award this year will cover \$50 of a retreat or family conference cost for adults or children.

WHAT TO BRING:
