A rather unique feature of the ministry of Cedine Bible Mission, as it is related to personnel, is that a wide spectrum of individuals can be used in the various facets of this work. Briefly, these are the qualities and characteristics that are desirable in Cedine Bible Mission personnel:

Spiritual: This is, by far, the most important quality. We believe that if a person's life is completely yielded to Christ so as to bring honor and glory to Him, the individual will prove effective in every way. Spiritual depth and understanding will be required in order to carry out the responsibility and purpose of Cedine Bible Mission. A close walk with our Lord and a real working knowledge of His Word are essential.

Educational: Missionary service is a high calling. It demands a quality just as high, if not higher, than that found in the secular world. Every missionary should have completed high school and in most cases Bible College, but practical experience, too, is most valuable for the effectiveness of those serving with Cedine Bible Mission. Any person serving with Cedine Bible Mission should be willing to continue to improve his knowledge and skills through college classes, correspondence courses, seminars, etc.

Physical: Good health, due to the demands upon a person physically, is of great importance. There are, however, limited situations where a handicapped person or one with some physical impairment may be used.

Age: Age is not a major factor for Cedine Bible Mission candidates, but it is important. Because of the type of ministry and the mobility necessary, it is a definite advantage to be in the younger years. However, many individuals will find a real place of service regardless of their age.

Character Traits: Adaptability, endurance, patience, perseverance, willingness, tact, humility, wisdom and discernment, co-operation, ability to work in harmony with others and similar traits are very important.

Appearance And Conduct: The same care that a person exercises in his work must be evident in his appearance and conduct.
