

The book of Nehemiah chapter one begins with a report that the walls of Jerusalem were broken down and the gates burned with fire

Nehemiah mourned the state of the Jerusalem wall so much, that He fasted and prayed to the LORD before asking King Artaxerxes for permission to return to Jerusalem to rebuild. When we get to chapter six, Nehemiah 6:15 reads "So the wall was finished..." What did it take for the work on the wall to get done and what does that have to do with Cedine?

Pray that our board and leadership will come together in unity, with a clear vision of what the Lord wants to do and how He wants us to do it.

Pray that we will have thankful hearts and not overlook the blessings He has already provided in the way of additional help. Pray that God will give strength, stamina and wisdom to those who have taken on added duties.

Lastly, as Nehemiah learned, no work of God goes forth without opposition from the enemy. Pray that we do not get sidetracked by the enemy's tactics. Cedine is still involved in a great work. Pray that the Lord will help us to stand.
