

Snow Storm

Since 2011 Cedine has enjoyed hosting the Institute for Cultural Communicators (ICC) group in the month of January. This year was no different. On Tuesday, January 9th, ICC leaders arrived to prepare for their Ignite '24 event. By Friday, their entire group of 96 had gathered. It was a great week and weekend with everything seemingly going as planned. Little did we know that by the end of the weekend we'd all be affected by a snowy, icy winter blast.

Typically, the ICC group departs on Monday morning. On Monday, the light snow that started on Sunday was falling heavier. Temperatures dropped and roads became more treacherous by the hour. As the group attempted to leave, only half of them made it out to the highway. 48 members of their group had to return to Cedine.

On Tuesday afternoon another 25 made the trek from Cedine to highway 27. It only took them 45 minutes to get to the highway; a drive that normally takes about 15 minutes. The final 23 of their group left on Wednesday. We are thankful we could extend a few more days of hospitality to our quests. There was food for meals. A few staff vehicles and drivers were sole transportation for other staff to get to and from the office. A few of the men on our staff escorted the last of the ICC group out to the highway on Wednesday without incident, and one of our biggest praises - we never lost power! We usually lose power in weather like this.

"Then at His command, it all melts. He sends His winds, and the ice thaws." (Psalm 147:18) Thankfully we're all thawed out now and always mindful that God is in control and He's the one that kept us all safe and warm in the middle of our snowy storm.
