Meet the Men's Retreat Committee

Cedine's Men's retreats started in the mid to late 1970s. During the early years Brother Tom Florence worked diligently to secure speakers and work out the programming details for the Men's Retreats. From the early days until now men that eventually formed the committee have worked together to invite and challenge men to surrender their lives to Christ and to walk with the Lord as faithful men of God.

- Vernon Tannahill became involved with the Men's Retreat after coming on staff and while serving in Community Ministries. In the late 1990's and early 2000's he began serving on the committee and has served several stints as interim chairman; becoming the official chairman in 2012.
- Gary Crawford started attending Cedine in the early nineties. He loves working with the Men's Ministry and bringing brothers together for spiritual growth and development. He teaches workshops, currently helps to co-chair the men's committee and is an active member of the Cedine's board of directors.
- John Williams started working with Cedine in 1975. Though he doesn't remember the exact date or year when he started working with the Men's Retreat committee he says it continues to be a joyful experience year after year. It's his prayer that men will continue to sharpen men.
- **Greg Samuels** first came to Cedine as a Cedine Bible institute student in 1977. After retiring from the military in 2013 Greg and his wife Jackie served on staff for a short time. In 2013 Greg was appointed to the committee and continues to serve on the committee to this day.

- Robert Benson attended his first Men's Retreat in 1978; Brother Butch Upton was the speaker, and Brother Tom Florence played the accordion. In the late '90s, Brother Howard Tannahill asked Robert to serve on the Men's Committee, and he still serves by God's grace.
- Garry Griffin, Jr. joined Cedine's staff in February 2024. He currently serves as Cedine's Camp Director and has worked with the Men's Retreat committee since his arrival in 2024.
- David Williams has been affiliated with Camp Cedine for over 40 years as a Bible quiz participant, camper, Leader in Training, Maintenance/ Landscaping, Camp Counselor and Men's Retreat group leader. David has served with the Men's Retreat Committee since 2023.
- Sean Moore has served as a workshop leader for the Men's Retreat since March 2021. Sean says that getting to know and work with the committee members and those that retreat annually with Cedine has drawn him closer to God.
